Each year a variety of scholarships may become available to students through Dublin United Methodist Church. To be considered for a scholarship, you must **submit a completed application to the church office (surface mail or electronic) by May 6**. To be considered for scholarships, ALL information requested must be completed. Below is a description of the available scholarships and the specific qualifications for each. Dewey S. Wilson Scholarship

PURPOSE:

This scholarship was established in 2017, honoring the memory of the first principal of Pulaski County High School, and a faithful member of Dublin United Methodist Church. This scholarship has been established to provide a student with financial assistance to continue her/his education at the school of their choice. This scholarship is awarded annually by a foundation established in memory of Dewey S. Wilson, held by the Holston Conference Foundation, Alcoa, TN. The Scholarship Committee of Dublin United Methodist Church will manage the selection and distribution process. **One \$500 scholarship is available each year.**

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The applicant must attend a two or four-year institution;
- The applicant must show a need for financial assistance
- Priority is given to a student in foster care
- Priority will be given to the student with the most ambition to succeed, not to the applicant with the best grades

The Munsey Family Scholarship

PURPOSE: The Munsey Family Scholarship Fund was established to assist students from Dublin United Methodist Church. The Fund was made available by a generous gift from Pam Pugh and Jeff Munsey in memory of their parents Ralph & Gloria Munsey. The Scholarship Fund will give priority to DUMC students attending Virginia Tech or Radford University. If no requests are received for VT or RU students, the Committee may select other candidates. Two scholarships will be awarded annually in the amount of \$500.00 each. It will be left to the discretion of the Committee if the same candidate is awarded one or more annual scholarships. The Scholarships may be offered to both undergraduates and graduate candidates.

- Preferred applicants will be attending Virginia Tech or Radford University
